Composition	The cleansing components of the gel are tensides on vegetable base, which are very gentle to the skin.
Properties	<p>The cleansing components in this gel are sugar tensides. They are among the best tolerated washing actives. As a result the wash-out-effect of the skin's own protective substances is comparatively low.</p> <p>The sugar tensides are produced from vegetable based compounds. Also, there are no foaming agents involved. Generally, these are inappropriate for sensitive skin due to their surface activity. Neither does Cleansing gel contain refatting agents that would only interfere with a subsequent cosmetic treatment. As a rule, due to their structures that often resemble that of emulsifiers, refatting agents are completely unsuitable for atopic skin.</p> <p>We recommend Cleansing gel for the cleansing of sensitive and problem skin at home as well as a just before cosmetic and dermatologic treatments. Of course, it may also be used for normal skin. It is free of preservatives that might cause allergic reactions.</p> <p>A lemongrass-type essential oil has been added to cover the characteristic smell of the sugar tensides. This, however, will not remain on the skin since there are no refatting components involved.</p> <p>Cleansing gel is suited for all skin types and can also be used as a make-up remover.</p>
Application	The cleansing gel is applied with circular movements and rinsed off with water.
